

UV/IR Flame Detector - obsolete

This Axis EN Ultra-Violet, dual Infra-Red (UV/IR²) Flame Detector is designed to operate in hazardous areas where open fires may be expected.

This detector is sensitive to low frequency flickering infra-red radiation and detects almost all flames, from invisible fire such as hydrogen to hydrocarbon fires. The flame detector has a UV sensor and two IR sensors which respond to different wavelengths of both the ultraviolet and infra-red spectrum enhancing detection through signal processing while minimising false alarms as only when both UV and IR are detected an alarm is signalled.

The detector signals an alarm state by switching an alarm latch on, increasing the current drawn from the supply from 8mA to 28mA and closing the contacts of a Fire relay RL1. The alarm current also illuminates the detector integral red LED. A Fault relay RL2 closes its volt free contacts if the detector has no faults and the supply voltage to the detector is the correct value.

The detector is tolerant to fumes, vapours and mist and suitable for indoor and outdoor areas. ATEX certified for Zones 1, 21, 2 and 22 and SIL 2 rated.

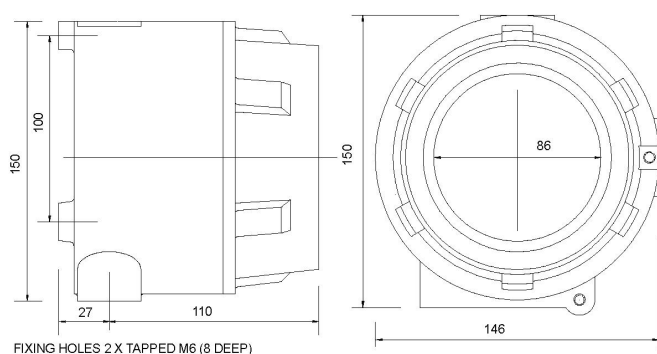

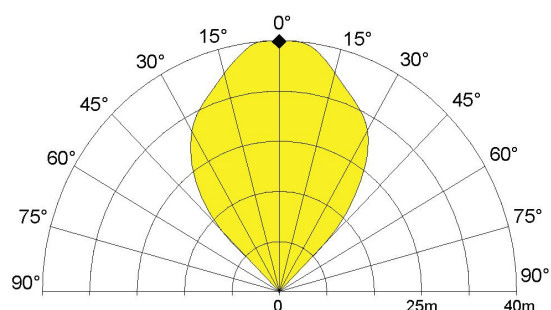

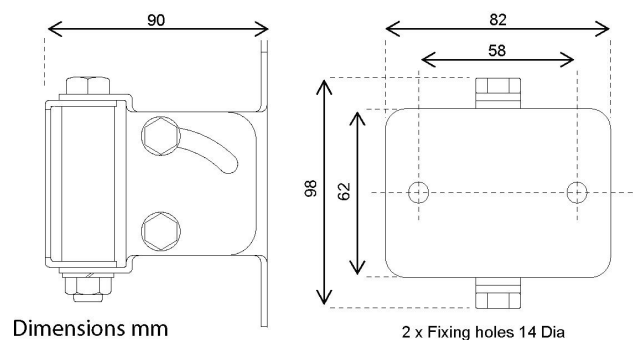
